GriefShare is led by caring people who have experienced grief and have successfully rebuilt their lives. We will walk with you on the long path through grief toward healing and hope for the future.



General UMW Meeting-9:30am, third Wednesday of January, February, August, September, November, and 11:30, third Wednesday of May.




Order an Easter Lily for Someone Special!



NEW CIMARRON DISTRICT ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

As you may have heard, the Oklahoma Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church is reorganizing from 12 to 8 districts, effective June 1. Also, our former pastor, Rev. Charlie Graves, is going to be the first District Superintendent of our newly forming Cimarron District. In order to establish the new district, elect officers and establish a budget, an organizational meeting will be held at our church on April 11. Bob Jones is coordinating a lunch that will include pork loin, potato casserole, green beans, salad, and cobbler!

Who should attend? Those who will be lay delegates and alternates to Annual Conference, those who are involved in district and conference boards and committees, clergy, and anyone else interested.

Seder Passover Meal Maundy Thursday, April 2, 6:00 p.m. Suggested Cost: \$8 per person

On the night in which Jesus instituted Holy Communion, washed the disciples' feet, and was arrested before his crucifixion the next day, Jesus and his disciples celebrated the Passover feast. Often referred to as the Seder meal, this will be approximately 1½ to two hour event which will include a break for the main meal. The service is based on longstanding Jewish celebrations of Passover. Other portions of the event include special foods which symbolize the events of God's delivery of the Jews from slavery in ancient Egypt. Holy Communion will conclude the evening. Because of the extensive setup required, reservations will be required by Sunday, March 29. You can sign up in the church office or in the narthex on Sunday mornings.
